Articles appearing in this journal are abstracted and indexed in *Historical Abstracts* and *America: History and Life*.

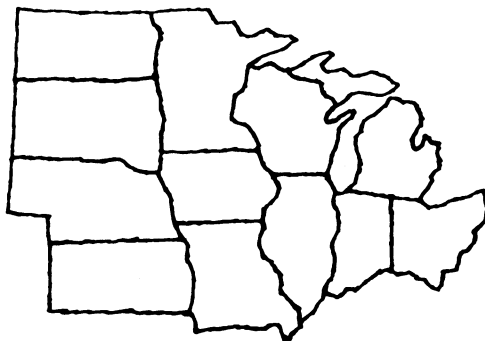
## CORRECTIONS
