

REPORT OF ANNUAL FUND DRIVE

NUMBER OF CONTRIBUTORS INCREASES SUBSTANTIALLY

The number of contributors to the Law Alumni Fund increased by 122 in 1976, more than 12% of all the alumni, compared to 9% in 1975. Much of the increase is found among younger graduates, whose gifts, modest in size, forecast a long term commitment to the Law School.

The analysis which follows shows the total gift income, the breakdown of alumni by regions

and by class. For the first time, too, names of contributors are given.

The Fund Drive represents a major effort each year, and shows a steady if small annual improvement. Clearly, what this Fund (and all others, too) needs is a dozen or so large gifts and bequests every year.
