What is Value Analysis, ( or Value Engineering )?

Value Analysis consists of groups of specific actions which produce better thinking in matters which will ultimately control costs, before decisions are made. Essential knowledge consists of knowing these actions, or techniques, and of knowing when and how to use them.

These actions are applicable to administrative groups, services, products and processes. They cause more good services or more good product to be provided for the user for less cost. They were precisely developed to keep all quality for the user and to do so at lower cost, or, if quality is inadequate, to increase quality with no increase in cost.

They have where used, already produced large benefits, however they are known and used to date, by only a few. Their basics can be learned in two weeks of full time well organized study. Their application can then be learned throughout about six months of use, by the astute.
