Ideas and opinions expressed by the contributors are not necessarily those of the Midwest Archives Conference or its Editorial Board.

Material in a wide range of formats — including articles, review essays, proceedings of seminars, and case studies of specific archival projects or functions — will be considered for publication. Guidelines for authors of articles and case studies are available on request from the editorial board chair.

Manuscripts should be sent to the board chair, Anne R. Kenney, 615 Elm St. Ext., Ithaca, New York 14850. The editorial board uses the *Chicago Manual of Style* as the standard for style, including footnote format. Decisions on manuscripts will be rendered within ten weeks of submission. Offers to review books or suggestions of books to review should be sent to the book review editor, Karen Benedict, 240 Mercer St. #205, New York, New York, 10012.

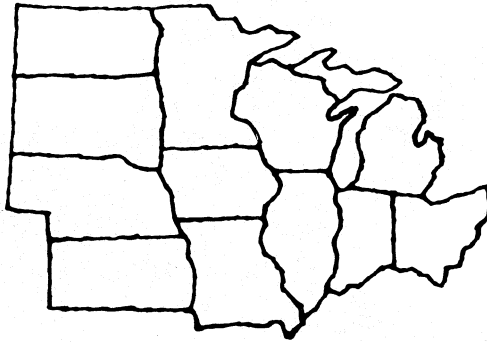
