CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

After coaching at Crystal Falls High School in Michigan, from 1956 to 1961, the researcher has had the good fortune of having coached undefeated football and baseball teams. Many questions arose as to whether new records had been established by these teams. In attempting to find the answers, it was discovered that athletic records at Crystal Falls High School were very incomplete. This study is an attempt to bring them up-to-date.

Purpose of Study

The purpose of this study is to bring up to date the records of all inter-scholastic sports in which Crystal Falls High School has participated. These sports are as follows: basketball, football, baseball, tennis, track, golf and boxing.

In addition, the study will present some historical background of each of the activities, as well as some information on coaches who have served at Crystal Falls.

Delimitations

This study will be limited to all years in which Crystal Falls has participated in inter-scholastic athletics through May, 1961.

Sources of Information

Sources of information included checking old score books and newspaper files. The newspaper files were: the Crystal Falls Diamond Drill, the Iron Mountain News, and the Iron River Reporter. In addition, graduates in periods where information was missing were interviewed. No specific results of athletic contests were obtained, but some interesting sidelights were revealed. The years 1904 to 1922 have some incomplete records. This affects mainly the basketball records, because the results of mid-week games were often omitted in the papers.

The first sports to be introduced in the history of the school were basketball and football. The second chapter will be devoted to basketball.

CHAPTER II

BASKETBALL

The history of basketball in Crystal Falls High School dates back to the year 1904. This was the year in which Miss Agnes Wells, then Principal of the school, started basketball using girls' rules. Although there were no records kept for that year, a game was played with Norway High School at the Opera House in Crystal Falls. The results as reported by Herb Larson, then freshman at Crystal Falls, are as follows:

The score was 100 to about 6 or 7 in favor of Norway. Many interruptions were made during the game because Norway had to teach Crystal Falls boys' rules in order to play the game. There were no backboards in the Opera House just the basket and they were not very rigid. After every basket someone would have to take a pole and push the rim of the basket up because it sagged upon being hit. The Opera House was very cold and the spectators sat with coats on. The school had not purchased any basketball uniforms, therefore the Crystal Falls boys were clad in old baseball uniforms with socks and for this reason did not feel the cold.¹

In 1907, Crystal Falls won the Upper Peninsula Championship by beating all the top-rated teams. Many of these games were played with city teams from neighboring communities.

The following year Crystal Falls High School registered in the Upper Peninsula Inter-scholastic Athletic Association

and played games with registered high schools only. This was also the year for the first rhabarbs to occur. They happened in games with L'Anse and Iron Mountain and brief results of the decisions follow:

The game progressed for about ten minutes when referee, Mr. Rayome, of Iron Mountain ruled out Charles Richards because of unnecessary roughness. As the home management considered the decision altogether too impartial for good sportsmanship combined with the fact that because we had no boys of suitable size to take the place of the one removed, the referee was allowed to decide the game 2 to 0 in favor of Iron Mountain. The score at this time had been Crystal Falls 4 and Iron Mountain 5.²

A similar situation arose in the L'Anse game recorded as follows:

The game was called after a few questions had been settled, and progressed until about three minutes of the close of the first half, when the L'Anse team left the floor claiming that too many fouls were called. They would not return for the second half and the game closed with a score of 13 to 2 in favor of Crystal Falls.³

The highest team and individual total for any team or player at Crystal Falls High School occurred in 1911. A game was played with Iron River and resulted in Crystal Falls winning by the score of 107 to 27 with Ed Burling, who later coached at Crystal Falls, making 97 points.

The Menominee Range Athletic League was organized in 1912. The league was comprised of the following teams:

Iron Mountain, Vulcan, Iron River, Norway, Stambaugh and Crystal Falls. All travel to the games was by train and all trips were overnight affairs. The players were the guests of a faculty member or the parents of the hosting ball players.

The small pox epidemic took its toll in 1915. The Board of Health canceled many of the ball games for that year.

The following year, 1916, Crystal Falls participated in tournament play in the Upper Peninsula for the first time, losing to Stambaugh. During this period there was no classification of schools in the Upper Peninsula. All teams competed for one title.

One of the best school records was established by the 1920 team when they won nine out of ten scheduled games, losing only to Ishpeming in the Upper Peninsula Tournament. The team also won the Menominee Range Athletic League by going undefeated in eight games. I. D. Wright was coaching Crystal Falls during that year and remained as coach through the 1921 season.

Harry Trainor took over coaching duties in 1924 and remained as coach until 1927. He was succeeded by Edward Chambers in 1927. Edward Chambers served as head coach through 1954, when he resigned because of ill health.

Edward Chambers was a University of Michigan graduate

and captain of the university basketball team before becoming an instructor in physical education at Crystal Falls High School.

It was in his third year at Crystal Falls that the Upper Peninsula was divided into classes, according to enrollment, for tournament play. Crystal Falls participated in Class B Tournaments from 1929 to 1935. They won District Class B Championships in 1932 and 1934. In 1936, Crystal Falls' enrollment placed them in the Class C Tournament. Teams coached by Edward Chambers won District Class C Championships from 1936 through 1947, setting a record of twelve straight district titles.

Other district titles were won by teams coached by Edward Chambers in 1951 and 1953. A record for the most consecutive Upper Peninsula titles was established during his coaching career. This occurred from 1938 through 1944. No tournament was held in 1943, a war year, and Upper Peninsula title winners did not travel to the Lower Peninsula to participate in the final state tournaments during any of those years. An article pertaining to the Class C titles was written by Gene Short of the Marquette Mining Journal and is as follows:

Eddie Chambers is the versatile coach of Crystal Falls High School, whose basketball teams, until this year, won six consecutive class C titles, a record no other team in the Upper Peninsula has come close to equalling and one that may never be touched.⁴

In 1938, a fabulous win streak was started and extended into the 1940 season and totaled 34 straight victories.

Bob Shemky won the scoring title in the Menominee Range in 1940 with a total of 142 points. He also made all-state second team in Class C.

The year 1954 brought to a close the twenty-seven year coaching career of Edward Chambers. Robert Boldt followed Chambers and coached basketball through the 1961 season.

In 1956, Crystal Falls won the first and only Class C State Championship Title in the school's history. They also compiled a record of twenty wins and two losses for the season. Coach Boldt was named Upper Peninsula Coach of the Year and two players, Fred Woelffer and Glen Westin, were named to the All Upper Peninsula Class C team. It seems ironic that during the week that the first Class C state title was being won, Coach Edward Chambers, "Mr. Basketball of the Upper Peninsula", died. He had set so many records in the Upper Peninsula, but never had the opportunity to take his teams to the state tournaments. Edward Chambers died Wednesday, March 21, 1956, not knowing that Crystal Falls had won the State Title.

Coach Robert Boldt went on to add to the records of Coach Chambers by leading his teams to five consecutive district titles, from 1955 to 1960, and four consecutive Upper Peninsula titles from 1956 to 1960. From the coaching years of Edward

Chambers and Robert Boldt, Crystal Falls won or shared eight Menominee Range Championships.

Coach Boldt accepted a coaching and teaching position in Carrolton, Michigan, and was succeeded by Stuart Smith in 1961.

Available records of Crystal Falls High School basketball games are recorded in the appendix.

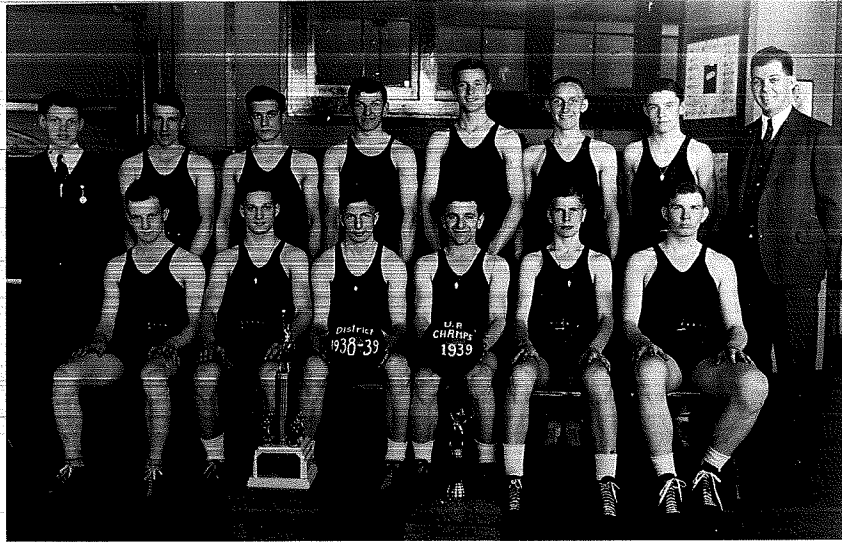


Figure 2. One of the Crystal Falls' teams that established thirty-five consecutive victories.

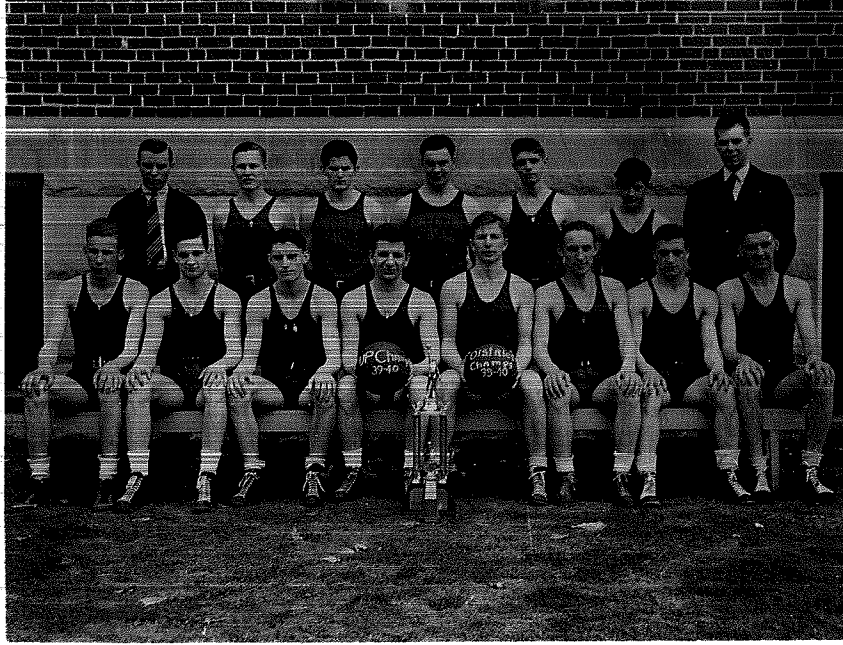


Figure 3. One of the Crystal Falls' teams that established thirty-five consecutive victories. (1939-1940)

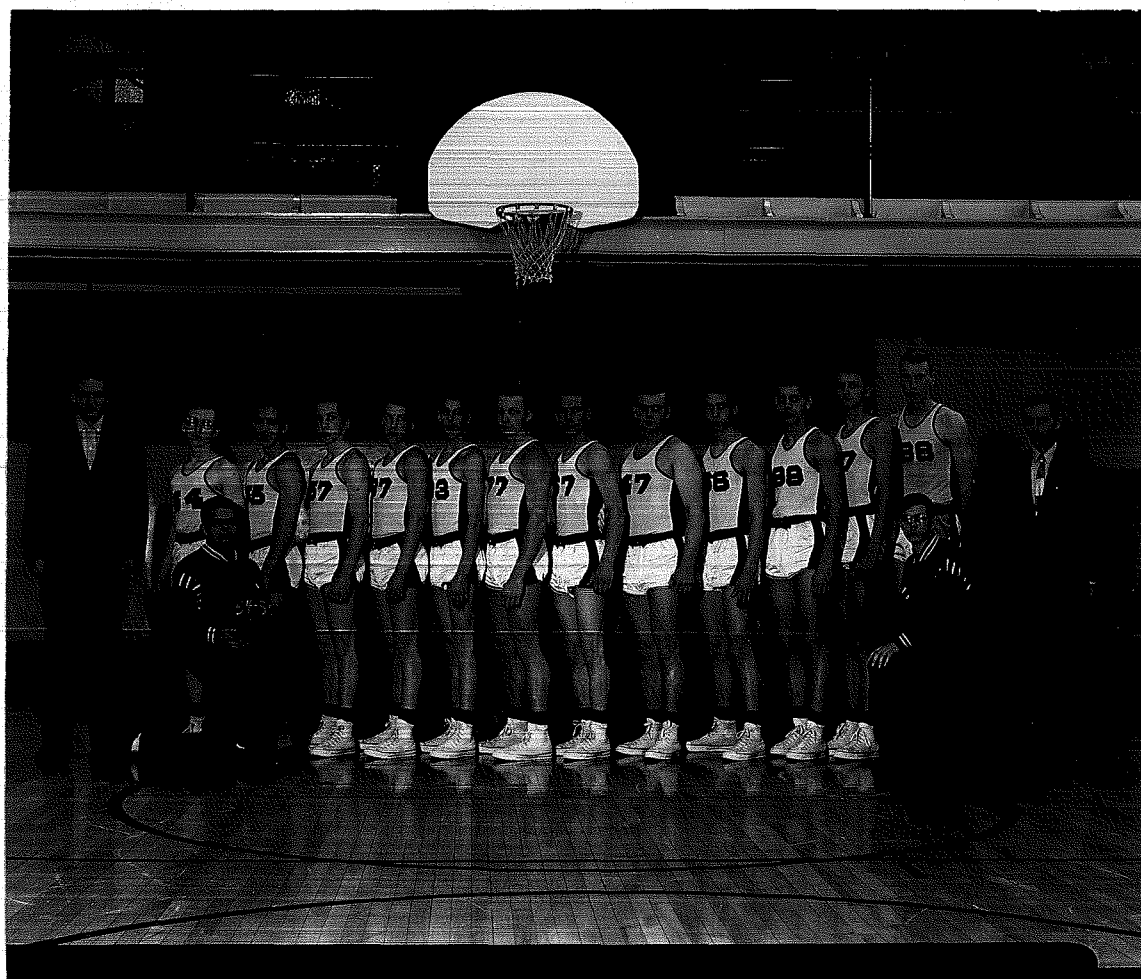


Figure 4. Crystal Falls' State Basketball Champions. (1954-1955)

CHAPTER III

FOOTBALL

In 1904, the same year in which basketball began, football was initiated. Phil Shaw was the first coach and two games were played with the Iron River High School team. The Iron River boys were victorious in both games. All other games scheduled were canceled for the following reason as recorded in the Crystal Falls Diamond Drill.

Will Lynch and James Spain have refused to play in the football team anymore, so the team has disbanded.

James Spain played a fine game at Iron River last Saturday but was so badly done up that he had to be taken to the hotel by the doctor.⁵

The following year one game was played with Iron River in which the Crystal Falls High School boys won by the score of five to zero. During the next five years no games were played, although some of the boys from the high school team began playing with the Crystal Falls city team.

A six game schedule was played in 1911, and that year marked the forming of the Menominee Range League. The league consisted of the following teams: Norway, Iron Mountain, Iron River and Crystal Falls. The Crystal Falls team failed to gain a win that year, and dropped football the following year, as evidence showed they were not ready to compete with

schools having more football experience.

Football again was put on the athletic program in 1913. Two games were played with Vulcan High School, also a school just beginning to play football on an inter-scholastic level. Crystal Falls lost the first game and won the second game. Later, however, this win was changed to a forfeit loss. The following article explains in detail the unorganized situation that occurred.

The football game last Saturday between Vulcan and Crystal Falls was, as predicted, a fight from start to finish. Every man was in the game to win from the time the whistle blew until the referee, who was Crystal Falls' coach, ordered his men off the field with two minutes left to play. This action on the part of the coach of Crystal Falls gives the game to Vulcan by the forfeit route on account of the fact that he refused to finish the game. The Vulcan boys scored in the second period but failed to kick goal. Then the Crystal Falls boys scored in the final period after being allowed five downs and with the assistance of their coach who actually took a part in the game and pushed his man over the line. As soon as Crystal Falls kicked goal the referee coach ordered his men off the field.

Athletic relations until now have always been of a friendly nature between Vulcan and Crystal Falls. From the standpoint of a spectator the game Saturday was clean so far as the players were concerned. We sincerely hope that the good spirit that has always existed between the two schools will continue to exist despite this little rupture.⁶

Football again took a step back in 1914 and 1915, with the teams for these years taking some of the worst

beatings in the school's history. Crystal Falls scored a total of thirteen points in two years. Again, football was dropped for another year.

A re-building program was undertaken in 1917 and 1918 when Crystal Falls re-entered the Menominee Range League. The results of this program took a favorable turn for Crystal Falls in 1919 under coach I. D. Wright, when the team won five games and lost one, the best record until this time.

The worst defeat in the history of the school was at the hands of Marinette in 1923, when Crystal Falls was defeated 96 to 0.

Elmer Ojala a right halfback for Crystal Falls made the All Range Team in 1924, an honor which helped to brighten the season.

Coach Edward Chambers began coaching in 1927 and had one of his players, William Waytulonis, a right halfback named to the All Range Team. William Waytulonis went on to become football coach in the high school from 1935 through 1940. Edward Chambers resumed coaching duties for the next two years. Football again was dropped from the high school schedule for the following reason:

There will be no inter-scholastic football in Crystal Falls this year. This decision was reached yesterday after a consultation between Edward Chambers, coach, R. E. Ehrbom, principal, and K. W. Schulze, superintendent.

The uncertainty as to the ability of L'Anse and Baraga to fill their contractual obligations made it necessary

for the local high school to drop the sport. Saint Joseph of Escanaba has also requested that their contract be canceled. Three of the remaining four games on the schedule would require traveling to Kingsford, Norway and Stephenson. The only home game assured would be Iron River.

Last year's football was costly to the school district insofar as the largest gate to be taken in at any one game was \$19.00. It was authoritatively stated that it is inadvisable to continue a sport when there is not sufficient interest in the game to make the sport financially sustained in itself.

What the boys have gained physically will be gained through a program which will be substituted for the inter-scholastic football program. Phases of football will be offered in both physical education and intramural interclass games.⁷

Football was resumed in 1946 with Milton Becker as coach. The following article explains the football situation at that time.

Football conspicuous by its absence from the Crystal Falls field of sports since 1942, will return to the picture early this fall when Milton Becker, recently named member of the coaching staff, will issue forth his first call for material for the 1946 squad. Crystal Falls will not take on a full Menominee Range schedule of games for several seasons. In time, however, if the teams meet with success, the regular Menominee Range schedule will be followed.⁸

The 1950 team, coached by George Rhenstrand in his first and only year at Crystal Falls established one of the best records when they won seven out of eight scheduled games, losing only to Norway by the score of 13 to 7. George Rhenstrand had replaced Robert Nichols who had remained only at

Crystal Falls for the 1949 season.

Wallace Hirsch began his coaching duties in 1951 and remained through 1955. Coach Hirsch was succeeded by Richard Mettlach.

Local interest was increased in 1957 when the Crystal Falls school installed a new Forest Park Athletic Field with lights, making it possible for all home games to be played at night. The dedication crowd saw the first game on the new athletic field and the results were as follows:

The victory over Florence Friday night established a record for Crystal Falls grid teams, this being the first year a Trojan squad has won every game during the season.⁹

Crystal Falls continued winning through the 1958 season, when they won all eight games, one more than the previous year. A record of nineteen consecutive victories was broken in 1959 when L'Anse beat Crystal Falls 38 to 14 for the only loss Crystal Falls had that year.

A number of Crystal Falls' players have been selected over the years to the all Upper Peninsula team. The complete list through 1960 is as follows: Bob Shemky, Louis Soha, Richard Takala, Allan Stacy and Brian Schulze. In addition Allan Stacy, fullback, won the Upper Peninsula scoring title with eighteen touchdowns and seventeen extra points for a

total of 125 points. Crystal Falls also topped all Upper Peninsula teams in scoring with 301 points, during the same year, 1958. Brian Schulze, in 1959, was named to the Class C state football team.

The year 1960 brought tragedy to football in Crystal Falls, with the death of one of the year's outstanding athletes. The following article best can explain this situation.

The cloak of tragedy spread its shadow over the football fields of the Upper Peninsula last weekend.

Mark McKernan, a young man whom any father would have been proud to call his son, is dead.

Mark collapsed during last Friday's Crystal Falls-L'Anse game and died a few hours later of a ruptured blood vessel in his head.

PRELIMINARY examination indicated that Mark's death was not a direct result from a football injury.

The football-playing sons of our state are now outfitted in the finest and safest equipment ever devised. The chances of a fatality in high school football today are infinitesimal.

It is tragic that Mark had to die at such an early age, but as a former player and now a coach, I'm certain football was not to blame.

MARK WAS no ordinary football player. When I prepared this column last Wednesday I wrote:

"Mark McKernan of Crystal Falls has figured in all of his team's scoring in the first three games."

"He has scored five touchdowns, passed for two others and has gained 326 yards on 58 carries for an average of better than five yards a carry."

"He is tied for the individual scoring lead in the U.P. and is regarded as his team's best defensive player."

Crystal Falls will be a dedicated football team for the rest of this season. Mark McKernan will be playing at eleven positions Saturday night when the Trojans invade Ontonagon.

This week's column is dedicated exclusively to Mark McKernan. All other Upper Peninsula doings can wait for another week.¹⁰

The records of the Crystal Falls football games are recorded in the appendix.

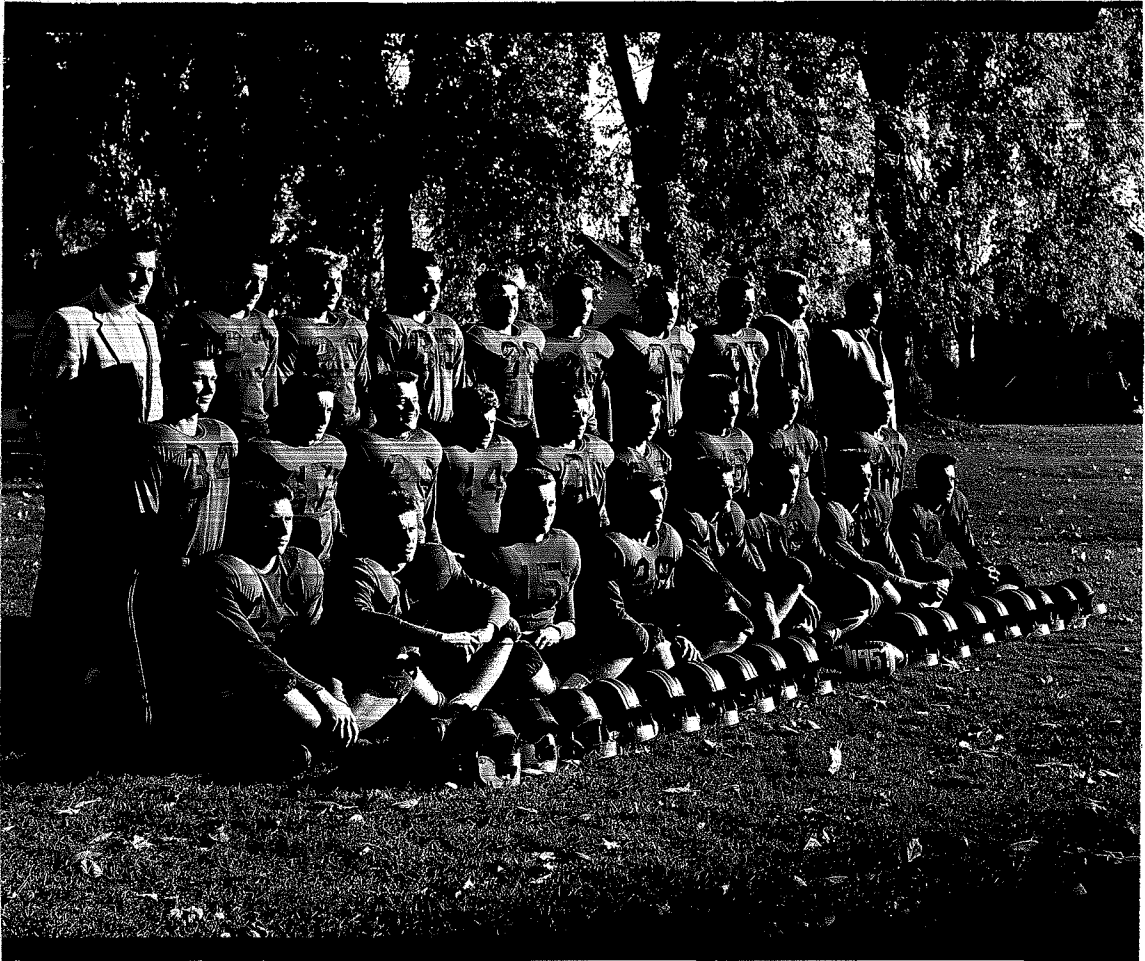


Figure 6. Crystal Falls' first undefeated football team. (1957)

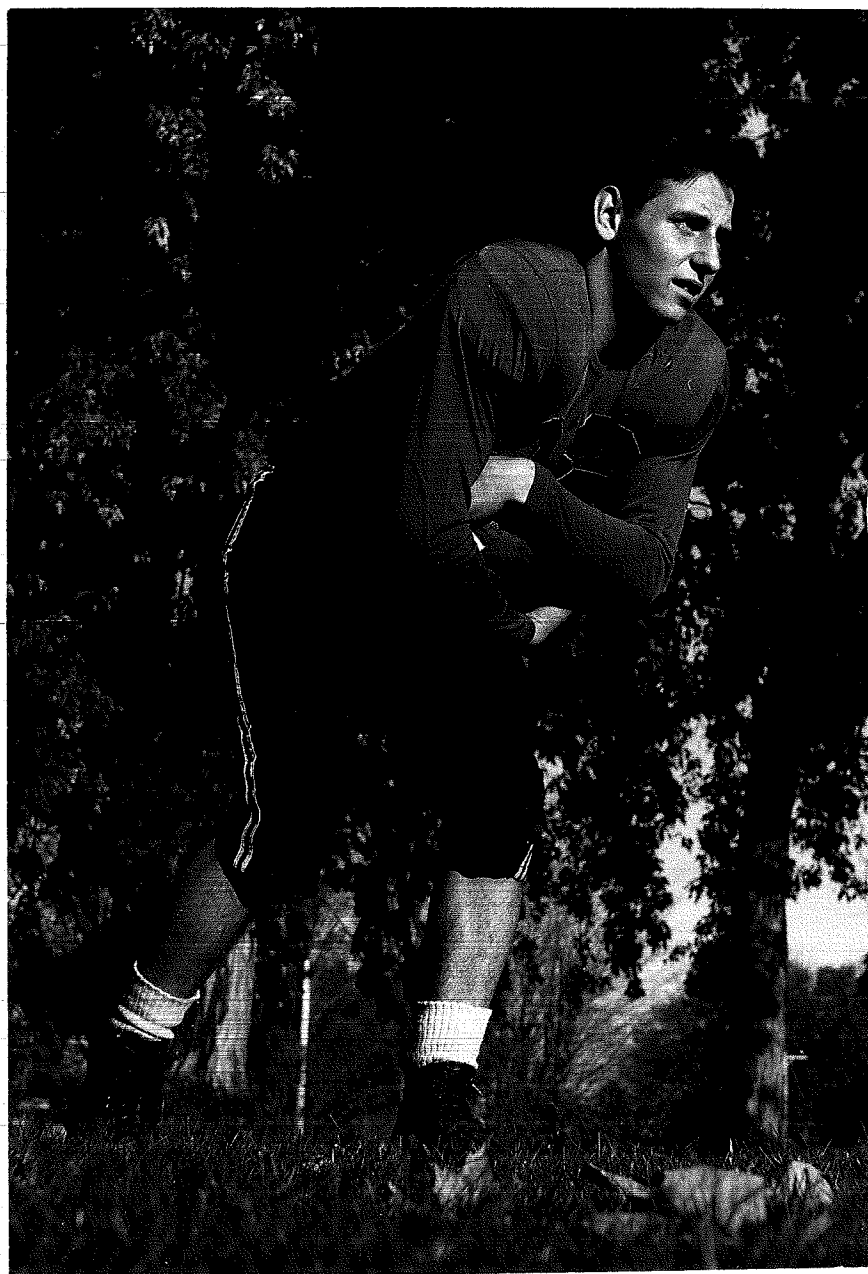


Figure 7. Crystal Falls' Upper Peninsula scoring champion. (1958) Allan Stacy.

CHAPTER IV

BASEBALL

Baseball in Crystal Falls High School has had a history of being an on-and-off sport. Mention is made of the sport in the early history of the school, but no records are available of games played.

In 1948, Crystal Falls was planning to revive baseball by competing in a four team sandlot league. The following article appears in the April 22, 1948, issue of the Diamond Drill.

Some thirty eager baseball candidates reported to Coach Milton Becker Monday night for opening drills in preparation for the first high school baseball season in many years at the local school.

The trojans will compete in a four team sandlot league, consisting of Crystal Falls, Alpha, Stambaugh and Iron River. The trojans will play the opener here, Monday May 3, with Stambaugh furnishing the opposition.¹¹

Only two games were played that year, Crystal Falls losing both to Alpha. Crystal Falls dropped baseball in 1949 for the following reason:

Speaking of high school sports, we apparently got well out on the well known limb several weeks ago when we made it our business to ask why baseball was not on the spring sports calendar at Crystal Falls High School. Our interrogation was answered, in part, and it goes like this. Baseball was originally slated on the spring sports calendar. It was originally planned to have a two division schedule in the Menominee Range. Crystal

Falls, along with Iron River, Stambaugh, Alpha and Florence, was to comprise the Western division. At the last minute, Iron River and Stambaugh decided to drop baseball for this year, throwing the two division idea into a tailspin. Crystal Falls was invited to enter the Menominee Range conference as it is today, with Iron Mountain, Kingsford, Norway, Vulcan, Niagara and Florence, but faced with the problem of distance to travel for out-of-town games and the conditions of the local field, school authorities decided to drop baseball for this year.¹²

In 1950, Crystal Falls joined the Menominee Range League and remained a member through the 1956 season. The Menominee Range adopted a summer baseball plan for the 1955 and 1956 seasons at which time it failed, and the league was abolished.

Crystal Falls began playing independently in 1957 and continued to do so through the 1960 season. The highlight during this period was the winning of eighteen consecutive games by remaining unbeaten through the 1959 and 1960 seasons. Brian Schulze, a pitcher and all-round athlete in the Crystal Falls High School, won fifteen of these ball games during this period.

A new Menominee Range League was organized in 1961 with the following schools participating: Norway, Crystal Falls, Kingsford and Niagara.

Baseball records that are available are recorded in the appendix.

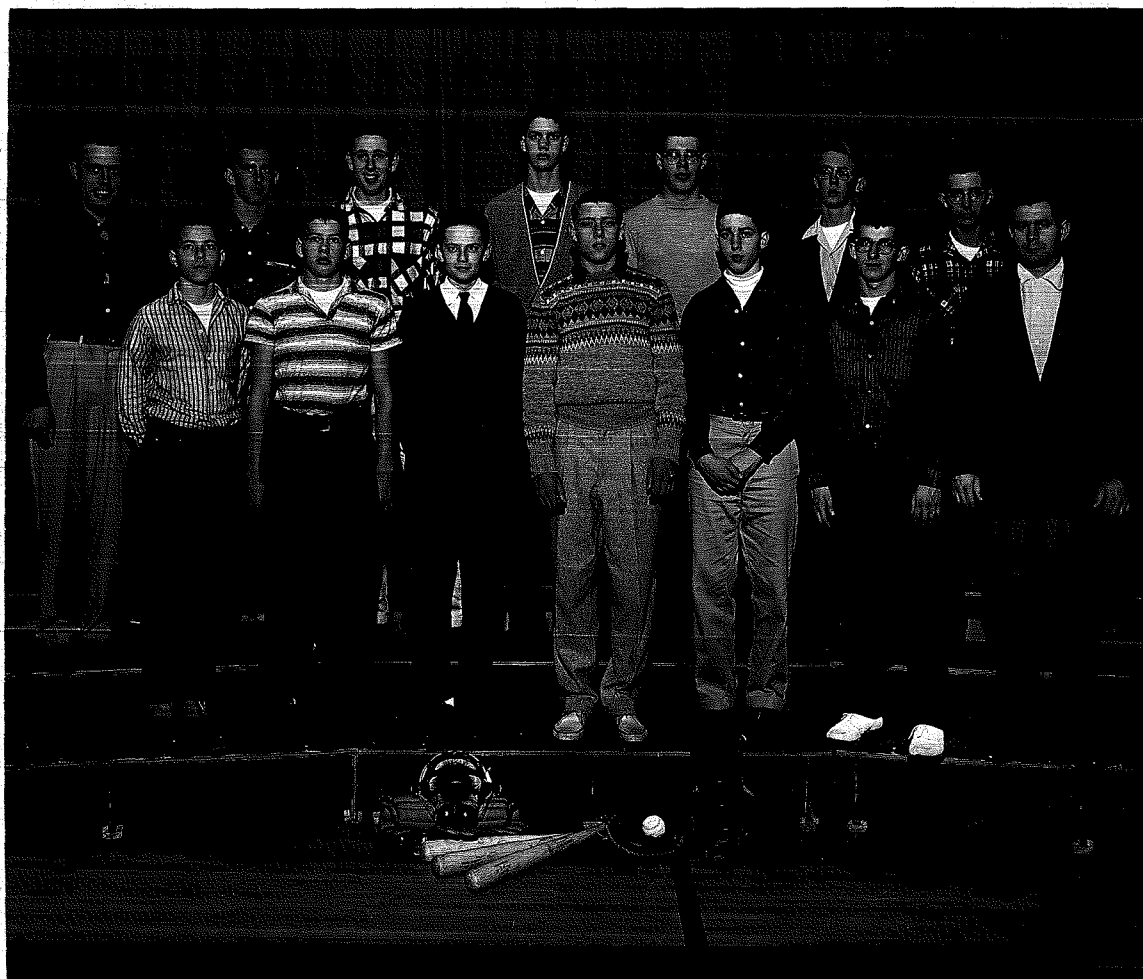


Figure 8. Crystal Falls' first undefeated baseball team. (1959)

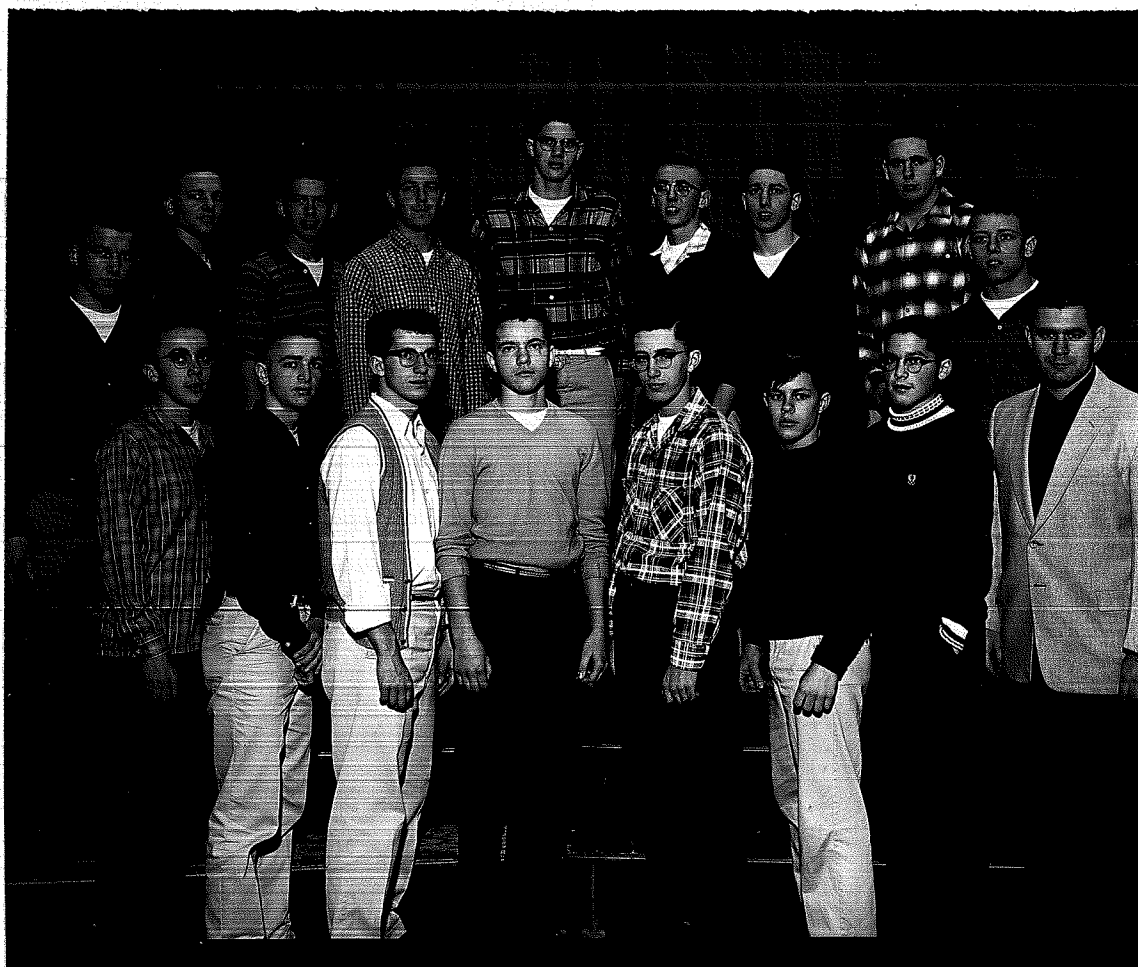


Figure 9. Crystal Falls' second consecutive undefeated baseball team. (1960)

CHAPTER V

TRACK

Track appeared as an inter-scholastic sport in 1926, under the guidance of Coach Harry Trainor. Only a few boys participated at the meets which resulted in removing track from the Crystal Falls High School sports calendar in 1933.

A squad of ten boys reported in 1943 to become the first squad to compete in this sport in the last ten years. The reason for adopting track again appeared in the Diamond Drill as follows:

Due to the State Athletic committee canceling all golf and tennis tournaments for the duration, it was thought that the new sport might fill the void made by the stopping of the other two competitive games.¹³

Coach Edward Chambers was in complete agreement as indicated in the following write-up:

Although the sport was participated in inter-scholastically last year for the first time since 1933 Coach Chambers believes that track fits into the popular physical fitness program and believes the boys will reap a harvest from the point of participation.¹⁴

Track remained in the Crystal Falls school through 1951. It was absent from the scene until 1955, at which time Crystal Falls again participated but failed to gain

a single point in any meet. It was dropped again as an inter-scholastic sport.

All available records are recorded in the appendix.

CHAPTER VI

GOLF

Golf was added to the Crystal Falls High School athletic program in 1936 under the tutelage of Edward Chambers. During the period from 1936 to 1943 Crystal Falls High School golf teams won four Upper Peninsula golf titles. The highlight during this period occurred in 1942 when the Crystal Falls golf team established a record with a team total of 360. Members of this team were as follows: Bernard Sacheck, Bob Nylund, Norbert Dishaw and Ed Onderak. In 1940, Bernard Sacheck established an individual record of 85 for 18 holes.

Due to the State Athletic Committee's action of canceling all golf tournaments in 1943 and 1944, golf was stopped as an inter-scholastic sport in the Crystal Falls High School.

When resuming golf in 1945, Crystal Falls got off to a fast start by taking first place in the Upper Peninsula Tournament.

Crystal Falls added another tournament to their record by winning the golf title in 1947. L. Nylund was low for Crystal Falls with a 96 score.

In 1949, Francis Alexa set a record for the first nine holes with a score of 42. The record for the second

nine holes was set by Bernard Sacheck in 1940 and is also a score of 42.

Golf remained as an inter-scholastic sport in Crystal Falls until 1954 at which time Edward Chambers, who had coached all of the golf teams in the history of the sport, resigned from coaching.

Golf records available are recorded in the appendix.

CHAPTER VII

TENNIS

Tennis began at Crystal Falls in 1930. Only two players entered the Invitational Meet at Escanaba that year. Interest seemed to increase and in 1935 Crystal Falls High School won their first Upper Peninsula Regional title under the guidance of Edward Chambers.

In 1936, J. Rezin and J. Royce won the doubles bracket, and J. Hoyastek won the singles to add the first Upper Peninsula Championship in Class C to the Crystal Falls tennis records.

Crystal Falls High School won the Upper Peninsula Championship again in 1938 and continued the torrid pace winning their fifth consecutive Class C-D-E tennis title in 1942. A number of Crystal Falls players won titles during this period. The complete list is as follows: Don Aeschliman, Ray Grattan, Angelo Albiero, Leslie Williams, Bob Lee, Vincent Stacy, Steve Mindock and Bob Leonard. In addition, Don Aeschliman won three years in Upper Peninsula Championship tournaments.

Due to the State Athletic Committee's canceling all tennis tournaments, Crystal Falls High School dropped tennis for the 1943 and 1944 seasons.

Tennis was again on the athletic schedule in 1945 and

is still on the athletic program at the present time.

In 1948, Crystal Falls did not win the Upper Peninsula Championship, but William Bottger and William Wiedrick copped the Class C-D-E doubles championship at the Upper Peninsula tennis tournament.

Ron Tirapelli won the single championship in the Upper Peninsula in 1957 and again in 1959. Brian Schulze copped the same title in 1960.

Crystal Falls' best season against scheduled competition occurred in 1957, when they won five meets and tied one, this being with Wakefield.

Tennis records that are available are recorded in the appendix.

CHAPTER VIII

BOXING

Boxing only lasted one year as an inter-scholastic sport in Crystal Falls. William Waytulonis coached the team in 1938, and the team record for that year was two victories over Goodman, Wisconsin, and four losses.

The only boxing record is recorded in the appendix.

CHAPTER IX

SUMMARY

In summary, the writer has attempted to bring the records of inter-scholastic athletics up-to-date. This history pertains to basketball, football, baseball, track, tennis, golf and boxing.

Basketball was one of the first sports to be included in the athletic program at Crystal Falls High School. The first game was played in 1904 and since that time, basketball has been a part of the inter-scholastic athletic program. Coach Edward Chambers, from 1927 to 1954, achieved great success by guiding many teams to regional and Upper Peninsula championship titles.

Football was also included in the 1904 sports calendar. Football was not completely accepted in Crystal Falls as shown by the number of times it was dropped from the athletic program. There has been a great surge in the popularity of football from 1950 to the present as indicated by the increased gate receipts during this time. In 1958, the football attendance was 2,930 and the gate was \$2,123.67. The football attendance in 1958 quadrupled the largest gate from any previous year.

Mention was made of baseball in the early history of the school, but no records were available of games played.

From 1950 to the present, baseball has been in the athletic schedule.

Tennis began at Crystal Falls in 1930 and is still in the athletic program at the present time.

Boxing, golf and track were included in Crystal Falls as minor sports and were eventually dropped from the inter-scholastic athletic program.

All available scores of athletic events in which Crystal Falls High School has participated have been recorded. The names of many of the outstanding athletes and pictures of some of the outstanding teams were also included.
