Material in a wide range of formats—including articles, review essays, proceedings of seminars, and case studies of specific archival projects or functions—will be considered for publication. Guidelines for authors of articles and case studies are available upon request from the Editorial Board chair. Manuscripts should be sent to the board chair, Dennis Meissner, Minnesota Historical Society, 345 Kellogg Blvd. W., St. Paul, MN 55102. The Editorial Board uses the current edition of *The Chicago Manual of Style* as the standard for style, including endnote format. Decisions on manuscripts will be rendered within 10 weeks of submission. 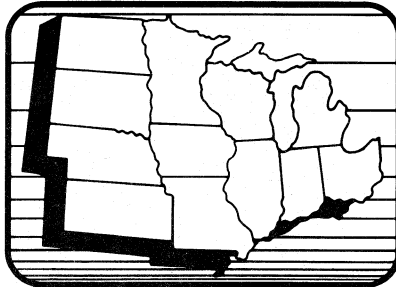
